## Participation:

- Each athlete may enter no more than four (4) events
- For the dual meets each school may enter four (4) athletes for each running event, for the three way meet each school may enter three (3) athletes for each running event.
- One Exhibition heats will be offered in the 100M, 200M, and 400M for additional athletes to compete but not be scored
- The 1600 M \& 800 M Run will be open events with no limit on entries per school
- Each school may enter up to four (4) Relay teams in each relay, only first place will be scored
- All field event contestants must sign-in with the event official during the first call for that event. Contestants may leave a field event for a running event, but must notify the event official before they leave and when they return.
- All contestants leaving a field event must check back in immediately following the end of the running event or they will be scratched from that field event. Coaches are expected to help with this.
- Depending on time constraints and number of Relay Team entries we reserve the right to run the Girls and Boys $4 \times 800 \mathrm{M}$ Relay and Girls and Boys $4 \times 400 \mathrm{M}$ Relay at the same time. Girls and Boys will be scored separately.

Order of Field Events:

Discus: Boys throw first, then girls
Shot Put (boys 81b, girls 6lb): Girls throw first, then boys
High Jump: Boys jump first starting height 4'6", then girls starting height $3^{\prime} 10^{\prime \prime}$; unless coaches agree to a different starting height at the meeting.
Long Jump: Girls jump first, then boys.

Each school may enter up to six (6) athletes for Long Jump, Shot Put, and Discus, for High Jump you may only enter four (4) athletes.

Scoring: The meet is scored as a boys combined meet and girls combined meet.

- Scoring will be 5-3-1 (1st place relay teams are only teams to score)

Ribbons: will be given to coaches at the end of the meet, there will be no ribbons for the exhibition events.

## Other Information:

- IHSAA guidelines will be followed
- A coaches meeting will be held once all teams have arrived with the meet starter and timer.
- There will be three calls for each event; Athletes must be at the designated location by the second call
- No spikes longer than $1 / 4$ inch
- No jewelry is to be worn during the event
- Concessions will be provided
