

# Ray Gerkin Cross Country Invitational, 57th Annual Saturday, September 16, 2023 at Muscatatuck County Park

**LOCATION-** The Muscatatuck County Park is located on IN 7, one mile south of US 50. Buses should enter from IN 7, **NOT from Gum Street**. There will be specific parking for buses. The parking attendants will direct you.

**COACHES MEETING-** There will be a coaches meeting prior to the race at **8:45am** by Shelter 5. Instructions will also be delivered via the meet packet and instructions from the meet officials.

**RACE TIMES -** The boys' varsity race will begin at 9:00 AM and the girls' varsity race will immediately follow (approximately 9:30 AM). Walking the course must be done prior to the race times listed. Each team will have a starting box wide enough for two runners abreast. Lane assignments are listed below. The boys and girls race will be unlimited runners for the teams but will score the top 5.

**AWARDS -** There will be an awards ceremony at the conclusion of the boys' race. Team trophies will be given and the top 10 individuals from each race will be announced. Individual ribbons can be picked up at the shelter house.

Team Trophy- 1<sup>st</sup> place team

Team Ribbons- 1<sup>st</sup> place, 2<sup>nd</sup> place and 3<sup>rd</sup> place teams.

Individual Ribbons-1<sup>st</sup> place thru 25<sup>th</sup> place

## In Memory of Coach Ray Gerkin

Hosting the Big Blue Invitational had been a staple of the Jennings County cross country program for 54 consecutive years. On August 13<sup>th</sup>, 2020 Jennings County Schools lost a beloved teacher and cross country coach with the passing of Mr. Ray Gerkin. In Mr. Gerkin's honor, it was resolved by the Jennings County School Corporation Board of Trustees that the Big Blue Invitational for boys' and girls' cross country be known as the Ray Gerkin Invitational effective immediately. The 2023 Ray Gerkin Invitational will be the 57<sup>th</sup> annual cross country invitational hosted by Jennings County High School.

Ray Gerkin coached cross country at Jennings County High School for 37 years, longer than any other coach in the school's history. He became the assistant to the boys' program in 1971. Gerkin would later take over as the head coach for the boys in 1980, a year in which three girls ran on the team and competed in four different meets. Ray continued as head cross country coach in 1981 and in 1982 the first full girls' team in JCHS history placed fourth out of seven teams in the Hoosier Hills Conference and ninth out of 12 teams in their first Sectional. That same year, the boys won the first of two Sectional championships under Coach Gerkin's leadership.

Coach Gerkin continued as head coach for both teams from 1983 through 1987. During that time, the boys qualified for the Semi-State for the first time ever. The girls team won their invitational title, posted winning dual meet seasons, twice placed third in the HHC, and qualified for the regional for the first time. Coach Gerkin returned to lead the girls' program in 1991 and held that position until retiring after the 2011 season. The 1991 girls team placed second in both the Sectional and Regional to qualify for the Semi-State for the first time in school history.

Coach Gerkin said his most memorable event was when Richard Scroggins won the Boys' Sectional as a Freshman. Gerkin also noted that winning the Boys' Sectional in 1982 with a team led by Tony McDaniel and Kevin Capes was very special too.
